It is important that you take time to read this leaflet which outlines the application process. There is increased demand for school places and you are not guaranteed an offer from a preferred school unless you qualify for a sibling offer. Distances of proximity offers vary every year, therefore you are advised to use all six preferences and include local schools which have consistently reached your address.

Please note:

- You **MUST** submit an application with all the required documents by the closing date.
- Your child must meet the admissions criteria of the school to be offered a place.

and there is

- NO automatic transfer from a nursery into a school.
- NO automatic offer of a sibling place without making an application.

Application deadline Friday 15 January 2016

How do I apply?

- **Bromley borough residents should apply online using the link at www.bromley.gov.uk**

Applying online is quick, safe and secure and gives direct links to school information to help preference decisions. The system is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week until the application deadline 15 January 2016. It is Bromley's preferred application method and is free, using an easy step-by-step format.

You can check or change details online at any point until the deadline Bromley Admissions will process the last version of the submitted application. The outcome of your application will be available to view on 18 April and offers can be accepted online until 3 May.

Before submitting your application you should:

- Decide on your preferred schools.
- Do research to ensure your application/s are realistic by checking the schools' admission criteria.
- Include a school whose proximity offers have in previous years consistently reached beyond your address.
- **Supplementary Information Form (SIF).** Schools with religious or different admissions criteria require applicants to complete and return a supplementary form to provide information to enable them to rank applications. They are available from the school/s concerned and must be returned by the application deadline. The school/s must also be included on your main application.
- **Medical and Social.** If you are applying under this criterion, complete the **Medical and Social Registration Form** (www.bromley.gov.uk) and return it to Bromley School Admissions with supporting documents **by the application deadline**. It is not possible to accept late applications under this criterion as cases have to be considered by the Medical and Social Panel before places are allocated according to other criteria.
- Submit your application on time with all the required documents.

You can apply for up to six schools, putting the school you want the most as your first preference. **Schools can be in Bromley and/or in other Local Authorities.** Out of borough residents can apply for Bromley schools via their home Local Authority.

Please note, preferences cannot be changed after the closing date.

Important dates 2016

Friday 15 January: Application deadline – **don't be late!**

- **If you miss the application deadline you risk missing out on an offer that could have been yours. On time applications will be processed first and all the places will already be offered – even if you have an older child already at the school or your applicant child attends the school nursery.**

Friday 12 February

- Last date proven changes of address taken into account for offer day.
- Last date late applications with good reason taken into account for offer day.
- The applicant's permanent residential address on this date will be used by the preferred school/s to apply their oversubscription criteria. Subsequent changes of address will be investigated and the implications discussed with the relevant school/s.

February

- Letter sent to all Bromley applicants confirming application address and preferences in the order they have been entered on to the admissions system.

Monday 18 April

- From 5pm online applicants will receive notification of the outcome of their application.
- Bromley resident applicants, accepted as on time, mailed an offer of a single school place (by 1st class post).
- Last date late applications will be accepted for inclusion in the May reconciliation when declined places are re-offered in waiting list order.
- Requests for further preferences can be made on the **Primary Additional Preference Form** available on www.bromley.gov.uk. These will be considered after the initial May reconciliation.

Tuesday 3 May

Deadline for:

- Acceptances online or return of offer letter reply slips.

May

- Waiting lists for all Bromley schools set up and maintained by Bromley Admissions.
- Any places not required will be re-offered according to oversubscription priority order waiting lists.
- Processing of:
 - Late applications received between 16 January and 12 February considered to have good reason.
 - Proven changes of address for ontime applicants received 13 February to 18 April.
- Appeal Forms must be completed and returned by 27 May.

When reconciliation processing has been completed

- Late applications without good reason received from 16 January.
- Proven changes of address received from 19 April.
- Requests for additional preferences received after 18 April will all now be included for processing.

The primary admissions process is managed by the Bromley Admissions Team in accordance with the Department for Education School Admissions Code.

When will my child start school?

A child should by law be attending school at the beginning of the term following his/her 5th birthday. In Bromley all children born between 1 September 2011 and 31 August 2012 will start school in September 2016. However, Bromley schools would consider a request for a child to start in January 2017.

Requests for admission outside a child's age group

Children are educated in school with others of their age group. However, parents may request that their child is exceptionally admitted outside their age group.

Guidance regarding the policy on admission of summer born children can be found via the Bromley website www.bromley.gov.uk

The Admission Authority of a school must decide whether or not the individual child's circumstances make this appropriate on educational grounds. Such requests would only be agreed in exceptional circumstances and after consideration of recent professional evidence and the impact of the child being educated with children of a different age both within primary school and when moving to secondary school when admission outside the age cohort cannot be guaranteed. - **Siblings** – You must still submit an application even if you have an older child already attending the school. Sibling status only applies if the older sibling is already on roll and attending the preferred school and will still be attending when your younger child starts.
- **Application address/parental responsibility** – Applications must be supported by documents to prove address and parental responsibility as shown on the application.

The child's current principal permanent residential address must be used. The address of a relative or childminder, or where your child stays or sleeps because of special domestic circumstances cannot be considered. All applicant addresses will be thoroughly checked.

You cannot use an address until you are permanently resident there and able to prove you have no connection with the previous address. All changes of address will be thoroughly investigated to ensure there is a permanent commitment to the new address and that it is not a temporary arrangement to access a preferred school. **If the applicant owns another property a temporary address cannot be considered.** This includes all rental agreements and moves to live with friends or family.

Any recent change of principal carer and/or parental responsibility (for example, if a child moves to live at another address) must be supported by satisfactory legal documents such as a court order. **Only applications from a person who is legally responsible for the child can be accepted.** If a child does not live with their parent/s and is looked after by relatives, documentary evidence such as a Will or a Court order are required as proof that the relatives are the child's guardians. A private fostering arrangement will not give parental responsibility. Please let Bromley Admissions know if a parent at another address is to be kept advised of the progress and outcome of their child's application.

Schools expect to see **continuity of address** throughout the application process and you could be asked for proof at any time. It may also be necessary for applicants to prove they are still living at the application address when their child joins the school. Places may be withdrawn if address details do not match the information given on the application.

If it is discovered that a place has been offered on the basis of a fraudulent or intentionally misleading application (for example a false claim to residence) that offer will be withdrawn.

How are places allocated?

Bromley Admissions will give your child's details to each school. **All on time applications will be considered at the same time. Schools will not be told which preference number they are or which other schools you have applied for.**

All Bromley schools receive more applications than they have places available and use admissions over-subscription criteria to determine who can be offered. Most over-subscribed Bromley schools will offer places using the criteria listed below, however Voluntary Aided schools offer places using religious criteria and Free Schools may have different priorities. Please refer to the relevant schools' websites for details and complete and return **supplementary information forms** as required by the application deadline. Refer to the relevant Local Authority's primary booklet or website for details on how places are offered for outborough preferences.

- 1. Looked After Children (LAC)** – A child who is (a) in care of an LA or (b) provided with accommodation by an LA exercising their Social Services function. Status also applies to a child previously a LAC but immediately after being Looked After became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship. Evidence is required.
- 2. Medical or social** – In exceptional circumstances there is discretion to admit children on the grounds of their or their own family's acute medical or social need for their first preference school. A completed **Medical and Social Registration Form** (available to download from www.bromley.gov.uk) and supporting evidence setting out the reasons why the school is the **only** one to meet the child's needs must be provided before the closing date, including: a letter from a hospital consultant, the special support service, social worker or similar professional. The application will then be assessed by the Medical and Social Application Group, comprising of medical, health, pre-school and teaching professionals.
- 3. Siblings** – children who have a brother or sister currently attending the preferred school and who will still be attending when the younger child starts.
- 4. Proximity** – distance as measured in a straight line from the front door of the home to the front door of the school. Distances vary from year to year see pages 16 & 17.
 - La Fontaine Academy will prioritise children who qualify for Pupil Premium and other Bromley schools give priority to **children of staff**. Details available on the schools' websites.

The school will use its over-subscription criteria to rank and determine which applicants can receive an offer. This information is then returned to Bromley Admissions and matched against the applicant's list of preferences. All possible offers are shared and exchanged across boroughs through the Pan-London Admission System.

- If only one preferred school can offer, this is the place you will be offered.
- If more than one of your preferred schools can offer a place, the offer from the school highest on your application will be allocated to you. The lower available offers become 'no longer required'.
- Any vacant places will be allocated to Bromley children living within a reasonable travel distance who have not received an offer from any of their preferred schools

Applicants will automatically be put on the waiting lists of any school listed as a higher preference than the school offered.

When and how will I be told the outcome of my application?

After 5pm on Monday 18 April 2016 online applicants will receive an email confirming their school offer. All Bromley borough resident applicants, accepted as on time, will be sent a letter by 1st class post giving the outcome of their applications.

- Only one school place will be offered.
- Offers should be accepted online by Monday 3 May 2016.

Waiting lists, additional preferences, changes of address and late applications

Requests for additional preferences can be made from 18 April on the **Additional Preference Form**, available to download from www.bromley.gov.uk.

Due to the high volume of changes always processed at this time, **Bromley Admissions will only be able to confirm waiting list positions from the beginning of June**. Waiting list positions will change as additional preferences, changes of address and late applications are taken into account according to the processing timetable (see below).

- The total number of preferences per child cannot exceed nine.
- Applications for lower preference Bromley schools can only be made under exceptional circumstances. They will be considered from May by the Admissions Team in consultation with the schools concerned.
- Waiting lists will be kept active in over-subscription order until 31 December 2016 when they are disbanded.
- To join new waiting lists, applications can be made through the In Year system from January 2017.

Reception 2016 – Key Stage 1 appeals

If you have not been offered a place for your child at your preferred school you have the right of appeal under the School Standards & Framework Act 1998.

Please note that the law states that infant classes must be limited to a maximum of 30 children which has an impact on how an appeal is considered. An appeal for a Reception place can only be upheld in very limited circumstances.

We would encourage you in the first instance to discuss your case informally with the admissions team on 020 8313 4044 who will give you advice and explain the process. There is also a guidance leaflet for parents on the Bromley website www.bromley.gov.uk

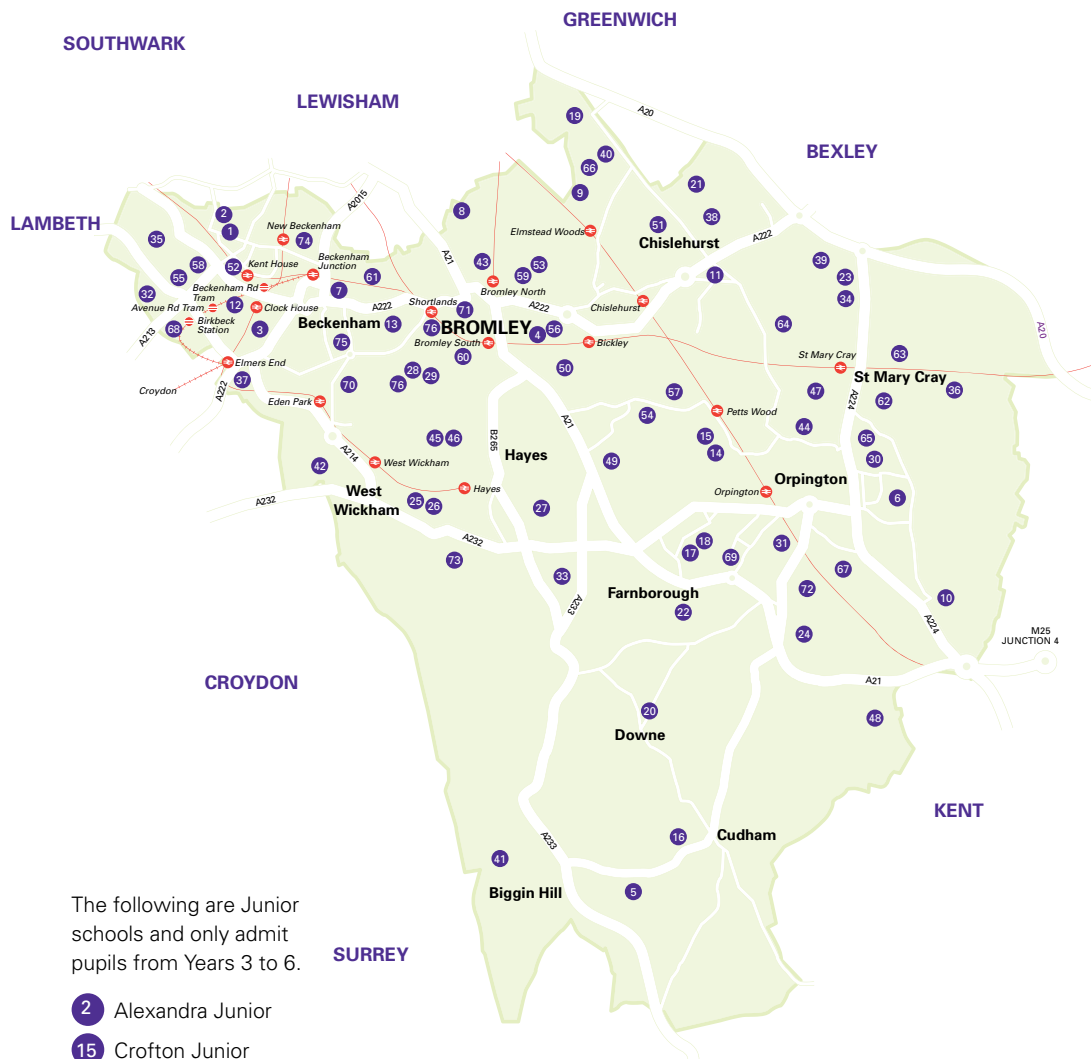
