

	<p>Design your own Roman armour to wear to defeat the Celts. How effective will it be? Think carefully about what materials it will be made out of and what weapons you will use.</p>	<p>Create something that relates to the Roman Invasion of Britain. You could make an artefact from this era or build a Roman / Celtic building. For example: A Roman Temple, Coliseum, Bathhouse, Roundhouse or Hillfort.</p> <p>You could also write an accompanying information text so that you can present what you have discovered to the rest of the class. Make sure this is in your own words but of course use the internet or books to help develop your knowledge and understanding.</p>	<p>Create a poster for a new toothpaste. The poster must have information about the new toothpaste and also why we must look after our teeth.</p> <p>https://kidshealth.org/en/kids/teeth-care.html</p> <p>Remember, you want people to buy your toothpaste so try and use persuasive language. Challenge! Can you keep a 4-day diary of when you brush your teeth and for how long each time?</p>
