UNIFORM

We expect all children at St. George's to wear full school uniform. We believe it encourages a sense of belonging and pride in the school.

Uniform can be purchased every Monday morning at 9 am from the Friends of St George's (a group of parents who form the school PTA).

Shoes: Sensible **black shoes** or suitable plain sandals. **Open toed sandals, boots and trainers are not allowed**. When you buy your child's school shoes, please make sure that they are able to do them up and undo them, as it is impossible to do up every child's shoes after P.E. Reception children will require wellington boots for the outdoor area.

Bags: Your child will also require a St George's style book bag or rucksack to be brought to school each day. These are available from the Friends of St George's.

Apron: Every child needs a painting apron, an old large shirt, worn backwards and fastened with Velcro is ideal.

Sports Wear: Every child will require a PE T-shirt (only available from the *Friends*), black shorts, black tracksuit or black jogging bottoms and a black sweatshirt, black trainers and a PE bag named in large letters on the outside.

It is also helpful if reception children can have a spare pair of named pants in their PE bags.

Jewellery/Hair/Accessories: The wearing of jewellery is **not** permitted. Discreet wristwatches are allowed but are the responsibility of the child. Children with pierced ears should wear small studs only, for safety reasons. These will need to be removed or covered with tape during PE lessons.

Long hair should be tied back at all times and hair accessories should be plain (purple, black or brown only). The school discourages attention-seeking hairstyles and adornments.

Nail varnish and makeup is not allowed.

Naming:

All items of clothing should be correctly labelled. This includes hats, gloves, detachable coat hoods and especially plimsolls.
